

The postgraduate program 'Informatics & Multimedia' accepts 30 candidates per academic year starting from October 2012. Applicants should possess a degree in Information Technology, Computer Science, Computer and Electrical Engineering, or equivalent from a recognized higher education institution. A number of scholarships are also available for candidates.

**Applicants are required to submit:**

1. Application: This may be obtained from the Secretariat of the Department of Applied Informatics & Multimedia. Alternatively, any standard application form may be used.
2. Curriculum Vitae including among other things copies of higher education degrees (or equivalent degrees acquired in a foreign institution), degree supplement indicating course requirements and the applicant's performance, foreign language certificates (especially English)
3. Brief memorandum of research including summary of undergraduate diploma thesis or final year dissertation (if required for the first degree), areas of scientific and/or research interests and reasons for undertaking postgraduate studies, work experience in industry, academia or research institutions (if any) and list of publications (if any)
4. Supplementary material including two recommendation letters supporting the application (these can also be sent directly to the Secretariat Offices), copy of the applicants identification (passport, driver's license or social security ids), contact details and two (2) recent photographs

**Notes:**

For candidates not yet possessing first degree, an equivalent certificate of studies may be submitted. Applicants interested for one of the scholarships should clearly state this in the application form.
